sweet citrus and old-fashioned rose.

Vigorous plants grow 3 to 4 feet tall, with good rebloom and disease resistance. Blooms are bountiful, up to 5 inches in diameter, with a petal count around 35.

Unforgettable in a bouquet, this rose is distinguished—a lovely addition to your garden or that of a friend.

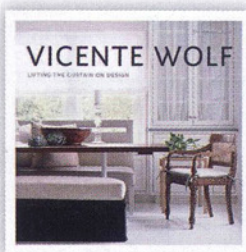
Carol Poet

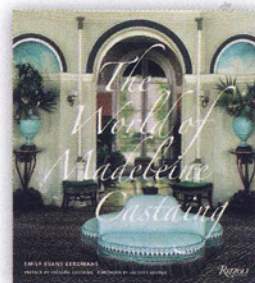
